Believed to have been occupied since the Bronze Age following the discovery of a cemetery and the remains of an Iron Age settlement in the village. Historians also believe Navenby was a significant staging point on the Roman Ermine Street, the Romans are reported to have maintained a small base or garrison here.

Navenby, originally an agricultural village, became a market town after receiving a charter from Edward the Confessor in the 11th century, which reverted back to village status in the early 19th century.

The Paddocks offers a mix of 62 desirable properties. These two and three bedroom semi detached and three, four and five bedroom detached new homes are being built in a range of differing materials including stone elevations to a number of the properties.

For those who wish to be involved with village life The Venue community centre offers regular exercise classes, a youth activity club and a number of other interest groups, the centre also provides rooms to rent for private events. The local memorial hall also offers a variety of local interest activities.
For commuters, there is a direct bus service running to and from both Lincoln and Grantham. By car Lincoln is 20 minutes' drive, with Newark-on-Trent (25 mins), Sleaford (17 mins) and Grantham (30 mins) also within easy reach. By train the nearest station is at Metheringham (7 miles) for trains to Lincoln and for faster services to North, Midlands and London Kings Cross trains travel from both Newark and Grantham main line stations.
