

Hawks Chase, Welton

Health

Education

Welton offers schooling from pre-school right through to secondary school. There are two pre-schools in the village along with primary and secondary schools.

William Farr Church of England Comprehensive School, rated by Ofsted as outstanding (2019) is also an associate school of the University of Lincoln.

Transport

There is a regular bus service to the city, which runs every half an hour. However, if you prefer to travel by car, it is a 10 minute drive to Lincoln city centre.

Trains run regularly from Lincoln to the North, Midlands and London Kings Cross.

History

Welton village is set in the stunning Lincolnshire countryside and retains its earlier stone-built properties in the centre of this beautiful village.

The name Welton is Anglo-Saxon and means the 'ton' or enclosure at the wells. Before the Saxons settled there, the Romans had occupied the ground, and before them a more ancient people probably lived there from about 7,500 years ago.
