Sarah Swift (1854 - 1937) founder of the College of Nursing in 1916, which later became the Royal College of Nursing (RCN) in 1939. Sarah retired from nursing when World War I began but returned to serve as the matron-in-chief of the Nursing Division of the Joint War Committee.
